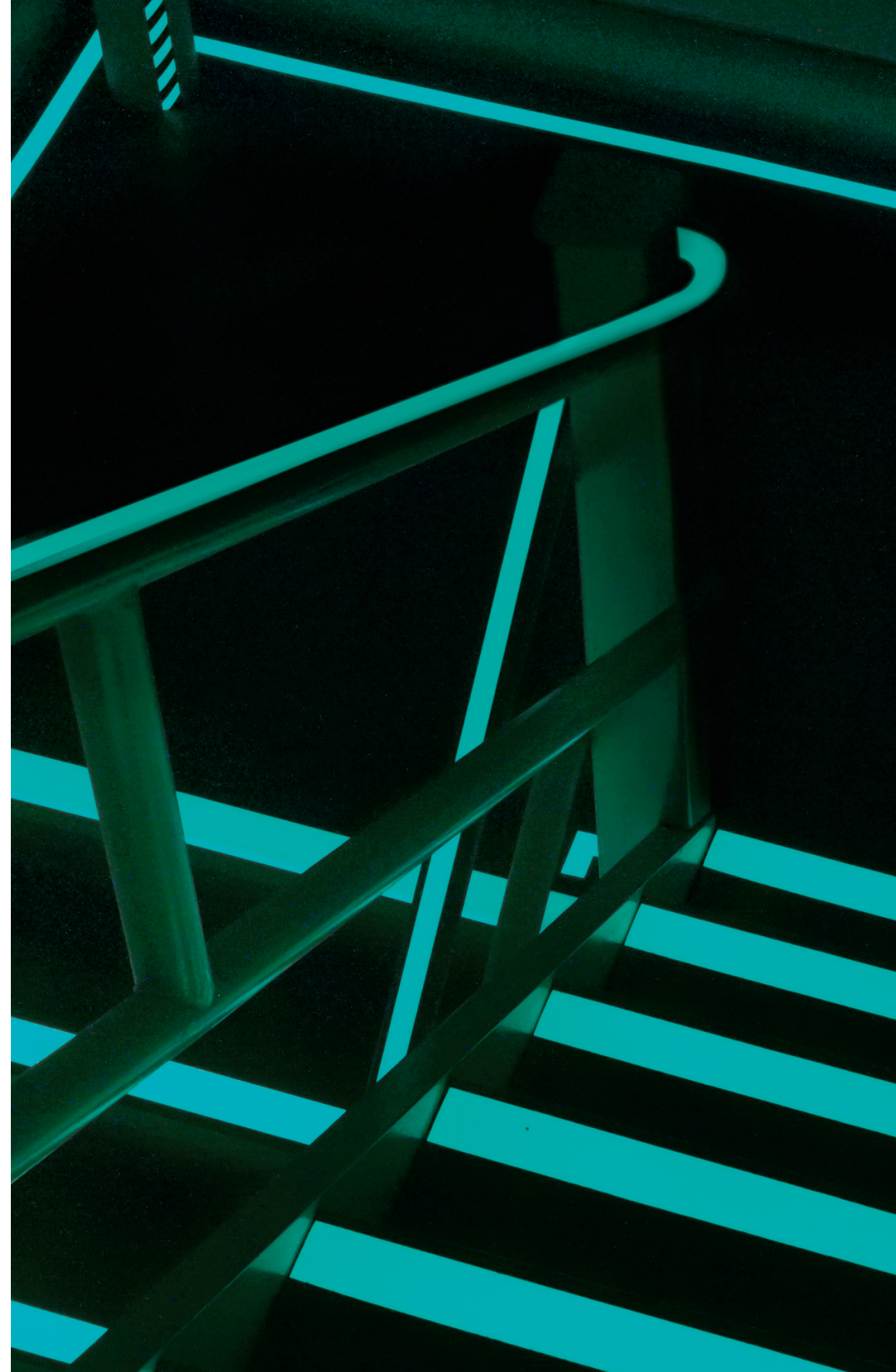

The science in safety

Safe-T-First® is a cutting-edge egress solution that harnesses the power of photoluminescent technology to mark clear exit paths during power outages and emergency situations. In low-lying areas where smoke is less dense, Safe-T-First crafts a continuous pathway through hallways and stairwells, helping occupants navigate darkness and remain calm. In a study by the US National Institute of Standards and Technology, evacuation speed in a dark stairwell adorned with photoluminescent markings matched that of a normally lit stairwell. Safe-T-First doesn't just light the way; it sets the pace for a safe and swift exit.

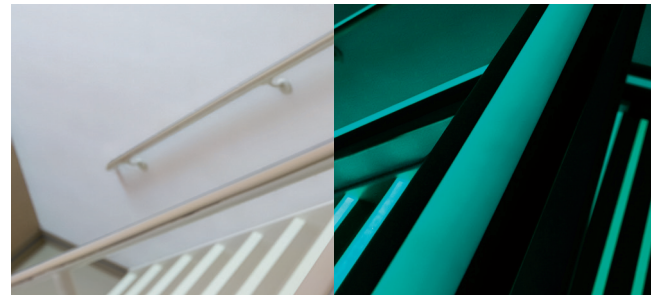


What is photoluminescence?

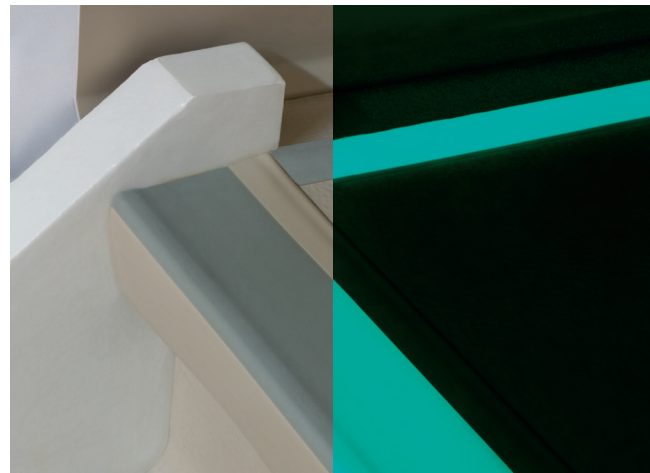
To create these pathway markings, strontium aluminate crystals absorb and store light source energy from natural and artificial light. During a fire or other unexpected power outage, the stored energy is released in the form of a yellow-green light. International Building Code (IBC) requires that all buildings over 75 feet in height provide approved luminous egress path markings within interior exit stairways, ramps, and passageways.



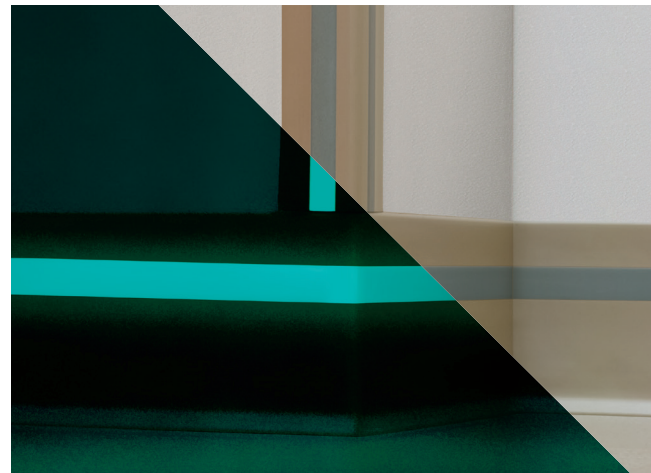
